She reviewed AFSC work on a planned parenthood pilot project planned for Africa. Monthly meetings were asked to discuss this and bring their views to Yearly Meeting. Hugh Maxwell reported that the Chicago AFSC office needs a person to head their program for non-violent workshops and distributed program leaflets.

The clerk appointed a nominating committee of Cecil Smith, Amanda Fraser, and Anna Mary Wilson. They nominated Kathryn Mills for clerk and Edward Wood for treasurer. The meeting approved.

Chester Graham announced plans for Yearly Meeting. Flora Maxwell added information about the Yearly Meeting program.
