

Blue River Quarterly Meeting
at St. Louis, Nov. 5, 1966

Blue River Quarterly Meeting convened Saturday afternoon, November 5, 1966, at the Meeting House in St. Louis, Missouri.

The minutes for the August meeting were read and corrected.

The Treasurer's report noted a balance on hand of \$169.25, and no receipts or expenditures since the August report.

Quarterly Meeting attendees were introduced from Urbana-Champaign, Clear Creek, Peoria, Bloomington, St. Louis, and Indiana, with a number of visitors.

States of Society, ^{were read or reported} by Turner Mills for Clear Creek, Donna Smith for Peoria, Robert Carter for Urbana-Champaign, and Edgar ~~Ad~~ Anderson for St. Louis. Difficulties in reaching unity on the Illinois Yearly Meeting minute on relief for Vietnam were experienced both at Urbana-Champaign and St. Louis. A concern for communication between Friends, a need for interior self-knowledge, and inner and outer wholeness were expressed in the Urbana-Champaign report.

The current situation in regard to relief for Vietnam was described, Clifford Haworth reporting that an export license for \$1000, good until December 31, 1966, had been granted to Illinois Yearly Meeting. \$750 was sent to the Canadian Friends Service Committee October 10 to be used for materials sent by ship from Vancouver October 12. As much of the additional \$250 as is received by the treasurer will be sent on ^{to} the CFSC before December 31, 1966.

Marshall Sutton spoke about the Fourth Friends World Conference July 24 - August 3, 1967 at Guilford College, Greensboro, North Carolina. No Time But This Present is being studied as preparation for the conference. Funds are needed for the travel assistance fund to help overseas delegates pay their way to the conference.

The Quarterly Meeting authorized the treasurer to send a check for \$69.25 (the surplus over \$100 in the treasury) to the travel assistance fund.

Clifford Haworth spoke about plans for the 1967 General Conference for All Friends to be held at Stephens College, Columbia, Missouri, June 25 - July 1, 1967.

After a moment of silence the meeting for business adjourned.
