DIRECTIONS TO DUBOIS CENTER

FROM THE NORTH: Rt. 57 South to Mt. Vernon. West on Rt. 15, 17 miles through Ashley. Turn left (South) on Rt. 51 and go 6 1/2 miles to DuBois Center Sign. Turn left. DuBois Center is 1 1/2 mi. down that road.

FROM THE EAST: Rt. 70 to Rt. 57 -(See above). Rt. 64 to Mt. Vernon-turn West on Rt. 15- See above).

FROM THE WEST: Rt. 64 to Exit 50 (Rt. 127). South 3 miles to Nashville. Turn left a stop light (East), go 9 miles to Rt. 51. Turn right (South) - go 6 1/2 miles to DuBois Center sign - turn left. DuBois Center is 1 1/2 miles down that road.

FROM THE SOUTH: Rt. 57 North to Mt. Vernon (See above). Rt. 51 - 14 miles North of DuQuoin to DuBois Center sign - turn right. DuBois Center is 1 1/2 miles down that road.

FACILITIES INFORMATION

HOUSING: Dormitory rooms, in the cottages, have indoor plumbing, showers and heat, and cost \$18 per adult per night.

Cabins, sleeping 4-5, have fireplaces and a bath house nearby; the cost is \$15 per night for the whole cabin.

MEALS: Meals will be served in Oak Lodge, where our programs also will be held. The cost for adults is: breakfast - \$5.75; lunch - \$8.00; dinner - \$9.50.

NOTE: All costs have been adjusted to allow us have children under 19 years attend free.

SNACKS: Please bring snacks to share for breaks.

WHAT TO BRING: Clothing for the weather; musical instruments; song books; sketching/writing materials; board games (for Saturday evening); toys and recreation equipment. Towels and bedding are provided.

RECREATION OPTIONS: Available at extra cost include a hayride (\$15 for a wagon that holds 18-20); pontoon boat rides (\$5 for a boatful, up to 12 people); canoeing (\$2); and horseback riding (\$5 per horse).

WORK SHARING: Table setters and servers will be needed at meals. Friends of all ages can help. Friends may also need to help with the children's program.

FINANCIAL AID: No one should hesitate to attend because of financial concerns. Indicate the amount you can afford to pay and join us!
