1<sup>st</sup> ans. All our meetings for worship and discipline have been attended though often small, unbecoming behaviour mostly avoided, and the hour nearly observed.

2<sup>d</sup> ans. Love appears to be maintained in a good degree talebearing and detraction mostly discouraged, no apparent differences

9<sup>th</sup> ans. Care is taken to deal with offenders nearly as queried.– No further business, the mtg. concludes ———
