

Blue River quarterly meeting of women friends held at Honey Creek 28<sup>th</sup> of 2<sup>d</sup> mo 1846

The representatives being called are present from Honey Creek none from Blue River or Clear Creek for whose absence sufficient reasons were given.

The 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> queries were read and answered writing from the monthly meetings and the following summaries approved of by this meeting

1<sup>st</sup> ans. All meetings for worship & discipline have been attended (though often small) except two at Clear Creek and one at Union on account of the severity of the weather; unbecoming behaviour guarded against and the hour mostly observed.

2<sup>d</sup> ans. We believe love is maintained by most friends in a good degree, talebearing and detraction mostly discouraged, and some care taken to end apparent differences.—

9<sup>th</sup> ans. Some care is taken to deal with offenders as queried.— The representatives by Clear Creek mo. mtg. to attend last quarterly meeting sent a satisfactory reason to this meeting.—

We are informed by the reports from Clear Creek mo. mtg. that they have granted an indulged meeting in Tazewell Co. under their care and wish to continue it which is satisfactory to this meeting.—

By the reports from Honey Creek we are informed that Union indulged meeting is in a very weak state but the meeting thinks best to continue it three months longer.
