1st ans. All our meetings for worship and discipline have been attended except one midweek meeting at Clear Creek on account of the weather, no unbecoming behaviour to remark the hour nearly observed.

2^d ans. Friends maintain love toward each other in a good degree as far as appears, talebearing & detraction in some measure discouraged, no apparent differences.

9th ans. Some care is taken to deal with offenders but not as seasonable as would be best.

The friends appointed to copy the epistles report complied with in part having no opportunity of sending them to Clear Crek and Plainfield monthly meetings.
