The 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> queries were read & answered in writing from the monthly meetings & the following summary adopted, as representing the state of society at this time.

1<sup>st</sup> All our meetings for worship & discipline have been attended except one for worship & two preparatives at Clear Creek owing to smallness of number unbecoming behavior guarded against the hour nearly observed

2<sup>nd</sup> Friends maintain love towards each other in a good degree, talebearing & detraction discouraged no known differences amongst us.
